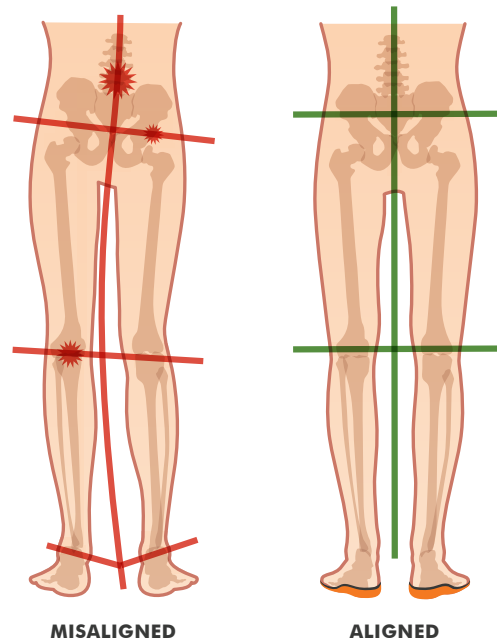


WHEN TO REFER YOUR PATIENTS TO SEE A CERTIFIED PEDORTHIST

6 SITUATIONS TO CONSIDER

1. Mechanical pain anywhere from feet to lower back (where a traumatic injury has not occurred)
2. Asymmetrical feet and legs with static weight bearing observation and gait analysis
3. Extreme foot mechanics (severe overpronation and underpronation)
4. Anyone who wants to start being active (pre-screening / injury prevention)
5. Anyone who is at risk of health issues that needs to incorporate walking and exercises into his/her routine
6. Patients suffering from generative or systemic medical conditions (OA, RA, diabetes, post polio, etc)

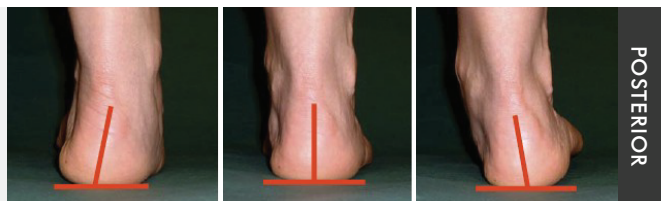


3 THINGS TO LOOK FOR IN THE FEET

1. Abduction/Adduction of the forefoot ('Too many toes' test)



2. Inversion/eversion of the calcaneus



3. Congruence of the medial longitudinal arch
